NORTHBOUND SH 360 BRIDGE DEMOLITION THIS WEEKEND

NorthGate Constructors to conduct bridge demolition for SH 121/360 construction

GRAPEVINE (August 10, 2017) — This weekend, NorthGate Constructors will complete bridge demolition for the SH 121/360 construction by removing the old northbound SH 360 bridge over Stone Myers Parkway. Below is the related lane closure information:

1. **Closure: Northbound SH 360 at Stone Myers Parkway**
Dates: 8 PM on 8/11 to 6 AM on 8/14

2. **Closure: East and westbound Stone Myers Parkway under SH 360**
Date: 8 PM on 8/11 to 6 AM on 8/14
Detour: [Eastbound Stone Myers Parkway detoured to Euless-Grapevine Road. Westbound Stone Myers Parkway detoured to Mustang Drive.](#)

The new northbound SH 360 connection to northbound SH 121 opened earlier this year. This demolition work will allow crews to continue the new northbound SH 360 direct connection to westbound SH 114. For those traveling through the area, please plan accordingly and add extra time to your commute. All construction work is dependent on weather conditions.

The \$61 million SH 121/360 Interchange project will add new direct connectors for SH 114, SH 121 and SH 360 that will minimize weaving, reduce congestion and improve safety in the area. The improvements were included in the original \$1.6 billion DFW Connector project, but funds were not available at that time to deliver the entire scope. When congestion funding became available for these improvements in February 2016, TxDOT and NorthGate negotiated a plan to rebuild this portion of the original project.
